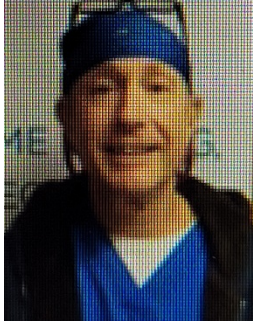

When the difficult decision was made to place him in a long-term care facility, she was involved in helping him and the family acclimate to the change.

When he passed months later, she was one of the first people the family notified. They were kind enough to share how grateful they were for her and her kindness in his obituary.

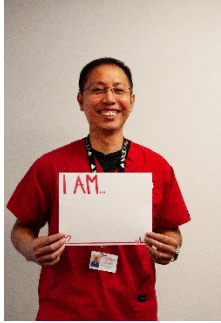

The client's eyes light up when Wilma walks into the home.</p> <p>Due to a close client-caregiver bond, Wilma is able to accomplish everything that the client wants in the day and more importantly, in the manner and order client prefers – starting with PT and OT exercises, which require great patience and skill due to tremendous rigidity of client's joints, then preparing her favorite soft foods and feeding in just the right motion and rhythm, followed by checking and replying to emails for the client, again with much patience and insight to interpret client's thoughts and words.</p> <p>Each vital task is punctuated throughout the day and evening shifts with humor, encouraging words/phrases, sometimes tears/crying, laughs, along with smooth and soothing Elton John background music, which the client loves!
